



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of understanding between Nilambazar college (Karingpuzha) (institution) henceforth called the "host institution" and Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University henceforth called the "University" in respect of organizational responsibilities in act as Study Centre is signed today the 24 day of Feb. (month) 2014.

1. The host institution shall :

- i) admit students (learners) on behalf of the University and receive the admission fee and other fee fixed by the University in the form of bank draft only for onward transmission to the University and charge no other fee from the learners;
- ii) provide at least 1 (one) room of about 400 sq. ft. for exclusive use of the Study Centre of KKHOU;
- iii) make halls / rooms available to the Study Centre to be used for holding contact classes and examinations;
- iv) hold at least 15 Counselling Sessions on fifteen Sundays for Six Monthly Course and 30 Counselling Sessions on thirty Sundays for One Year Course.
- v) extend library facilities to the learners of KKHOU;
- vi) provide laboratory and Computer facilities to the learners of KKHOU for specialized programmes requiring institutional infrastructure facilities on mutually agreed terms;
- vii) have telephone, fax / e-mail facilities;
- viii) ensure security of the University properties provided to the Study Centre by the University;
- ix) not use the equipments and other properties received from the University for any other purpose without written permission from the University;
- x) convey to the learners various information and instructions issued by the University from time to time;
- xi) display prominently a signboard of KKHOU Study Centre with the emblem of the University in its reverse page superimposed on it ;
- xii) allow the authorized officer of the University to inspect the functioning of the Study Centre as and when necessary;
- xiii) give one (academic) year's notice to the University in the event of its unilateral decision to discontinue as Study Centre and take full responsibility of the enrolled learner's future on its failure to do so.

2. The University shall :

- i) provide self learning materials (SLM) for distribution among the learners;
- ii) at the initial stage refund 50 % of the course fee collected from the learners and 20 % of the sale proceeds of application forms and prospectus to the Study Centre for its maintenance including counselling classes;
- iii) provide one computer with a printer to those Study Centres which enroll more than 150 learners and one additional TV set with DVD players to those Study Centres enrolling more than 200 learners in order to facilitate its better functioning, however, the ownership of these equipments will rest with the University
- iv) defray travelling expenses to the head of the host institution/project coordinator/other faculty members whenever invited/deputed by the University to attend seminar/workshop etc. ;
- v) consider to take over the maintenance of the Study Centre based on its performance for at least two years;
- vi) sign a separate MOU with the host institution if the University decides to bear the full maintenance cost of the Study Centre.
- vii) give one (academic) year's notice to the host institution in case of any unilateral decision to discontinue the Study Centre and take full responsibility of the learners enrolled in the institution

In order to promote co-operation and advancement of research, teaching and academic exchanges between NBC, N and SVC, C the two institutions agree to formalize a MoU as follows:

1. Based on the principles of mutual benefits and respect for each others' independence, the two institutions will foster:

- A) STUDENT EXCHANGE
- B) FACULTY EXCHANGE
- C) EXCHANGE OF ACADEMIC MATERIALS
- D) SHORT TERM PROGRAMMES
- E) CULTURAL EXCHANGE

2. In order to carry out the above activities, suggestions may come from IQAC of both the colleges, based on which a detailed plans may be approved from time to time by a 8 member committee consisting of Principal, two senior teacher and IQAC Co-Ordinator of each Institution. This Committee will be called Inter College Committee for Academic Cultural Exchanges and Co-operation (ICCACEC).

3. It is implicit that every activity undertaken this agreement is approved by the appropriate officials of each institution and must fall within each institution's academic and fiscal constraints.

Quorum of the committee will be formed only when at least 6 numbers are present including two Heads of the Institution in person.

4. In the interest of expanding educational opportunities, both the colleges agree to facilitate exchange programme as under:

I. Student Exchange Programme

i. Administrative Body

The exchange programme shall be administered through the committee of 8 members as constituted as under para 2 of the MoU (ICCACEC).

ii. Duration of Exchange

Each institution agrees to exchange individual students for seven days on a one to one basis.

iii. Number of students

In principle, each institution may send 5 students (one from each faculty, if available) from UG classes.

iv. Student Programme Fees/benefits to host institution.

There shall be any fees payable to host institution. However, they will pay all dues payable to host institution. Additional benefits for the exchange of student may be provided by mutual agreement. However, if the host institution agrees to help the exchange of students by providing suitable accommodation to the students. All meal, accommodation and travel cost will be the responsibility of the individual students.

v. The Indemnity

Each participant should submit indemnity bond, health certificate and risk certificate duly countersigned by their parents.

vi. Student Eligibility

The obligation of each institution will be to designate meritorious students for participation in the programme. There should be a letter of recommendation and certified bio-data from the home institution.

II. Faculty Exchange

i. Administrative Body

The exchange programme shall be administered through Governing Body of the host institution on the basis of recommendation from (ICCACEC).

Duration of exchange, number of teachers and eligibility etc. shall be determined by the committee of 8 as stated in para 2 above (ICCACEC). Expenditure to be borne by the host institution may be fixed by mutual agreement between two heads of Institution and concerned teachers.

III. Exchange of academic materials

Subject to the approval of the Governing Body the Research Cell of the home institution will be administrative body to fix all details about exchanges on the basis of recommendation made by the (ICCACEC).

IV. Short Term Programme

Each institution will encourage different departments to organize joint programme such as seminars, conferences, workshop, FDP etc.

V. Cultural Exchange

Both the institution make effort for promotions of values and cultures through cultural exchange.

5. Evaluation and Certification

The host institution will evaluate the individual participants in the exchange programme and arrange certificates to participants.

6. Intellectual Property

The terms and exploration of the intellectual property invention and innovation will be negotiated on a project- by project basis by the committee - of four on approval of apex body of each of the institution.

7. Validity of MoU

This MoU will remain in force for five (05) years after which it may be extended on yearly basis, if both the college mutually agree.

8. The agreement shall be effective on and after the date of signing by the Head of the Institutions and remain in force for five(05) years or the date on which either party wishes to terminate during that period. In order to terminate a written notice of thirty days shall have to be served showing reason of termination.
