The main objectives of carrying out Green Audit are:

- To introduce and make students aware of real concerns of environment and its sustainability.
- To secure the environment and cut down the threats posed to human health by analyzing the pattern and extent of resource use on the campus.
- To establish a baseline data to assess future sustainability by avoiding the interruptions in environment that are more difficult to handle and their corrections require high cost.
- To bring out a status report on environmental compliance.

3. Methodology:

In order to perform green audit, the methodology included different tools such as preparation of questionnaire, physical inspection of the campus, observation and review of the documentation, interviewing key persons and data analysis, measurements and recommendations. The study covered the following areas to summaries the present status of environment management in the campus:

- Water management
- · Energy conservation
- Waste management
- · E-waste management
- Green area management



4. Auditing Water Consumption:

Water auditing is conducted for the evaluation of raw water intake and determining the facilities for water treatment and reuse. The present investigation tries to find out a way that can be adopted and implemented to balance the demand and supply of water. It is therefore essential that any environmentally responsable institution examine its water use practices. Main water uses in the College campus are in Gardening, Cleaning, Canteen, Drinking, Toilets, Bathrooms, Hostel, Washing, Construction works and Office uses.

- Leakages from taps
- · Over use of water.

Recommendations

- All leaking tapes to be repaired.
- · Establishment rain water harvesting system
- Involve students by giving them real time projects on water conservation and rewardgood ideas after implementing them
- Use of tap water can be controlled by regulating discharge per hour.
 Provide pushbutton taps limiting the time for 30 secs
- Canteen can reduce the use of trays to a certain extent.
- · Installation of water treatment system.

4.2. Auditing Energy management

This indicator addresses energy consumption, energy sources, energy monitoring, lighting, appliances, and vehicles. Energy use is clearly an important aspect of campus sustainability and thus requires no explanation for its inclusion in the assessment. Energy auditing deals with the conservation and methods to reduce its consumption related to environmental degradation. Electricity saving methods adopted in the college

- · Turn off electrical equipments when not in use
- Use energy efficient Light-Emitting Diode (LED) bulbs instead of incandescent and CFL bulbs.
- Maintain fault free appliances and replace old appliances.
- Use computers and electronic equipments in power saving mode.

Energy Audit Observations

- The college has assessed the electrical load calculation.
- Looking at the range of college activities and working hours, monthly use of electricity in the college is very high.
- There are fans of older generation and non energy efficient which can be phase out by replacing with new energy efficient fans.
- Regular monitoring of equipments and immediate rectification of any problems.
- Awareness on conservation of energy, water and fuel consumption needs to be communicated among the stakeholders.

The total energy utilization of the college for different purposes is approximately 300 units/p.m and electricity charges per month are Rs.4000/-p.m

Recommendations

- Installation of solar panel to tape the non conventional sources of energy.
- Energy saving through the replacement of tube lights to LED lights.
- Energy efficient electrical equipments especially fans and pump sets can be replaced against old ones.
- Awareness programs for the stakeholders to save energy may also increasesustainability in the utilization of various energy sources.



4.3. Waste Generation

This indicator addresses waste production and disposal of different wastes like paper, food, plastic, biodegradable waste, glass, dust etc. and recycling. Furthermore, solid waste often includes wasted material resources that could otherwise be channeled into better service through recycling, repair and reuse. Solid waste generation and management is a burning issue. Unscientific handling of solid waste can create threats to everyone. The survey focused on volume, type and current management practice of solid waste generated in the campus. The different solid wastes collected are as mentioned above.

(a) Observations:

The total solid was be collected in the campus is 10kg/day. Waste generated from dead organic matter is a major solid waste in the campus. The waste is segregated at source by providing separate dustbins for Biodegradable and Non Bio-degradable waste. Segregation of chemical waste generated in laboratories is also practiced. Single sided used papers are reused for writing and printing in all departments. Important and confidential reports/ papers are sent for recycling after completion of their preservation period. Very less plastic waste (0.3kg/day) is generated by some departments, office, garden etc. but it is neither categorized at point source nor sent for recycling. Metal waste and wooden waste is stored and given to authorized scrap agents for further processing. The tree droppings are sent for composting plant

(b) Recommendations

Reduce the absolute amount of Organic waste that is produced from college.

- · Make full use of all recycling facilities provided by Local bodies.
- Corporation and private suppliers including glass, cans, white coloured and brown paper, plastic bottles, batteries, print cartridges, cardboard and furniture. Provide sufficient, accessible and well-publicized collection points for
- recyclable waste, with responsibility for recycling clearly allocated.
 The main purpose of vermi-compostingis to reduce solid organic disposable
- waste in the college campus. After complete process of composting, it is used as manure in the garden and lawns.

WASTE DISPOSAL OF NILAMBAZAR COLLEGE

With smart initiatives like our Think Green Campus Model, Waste Management is helping colleges and universities achieve a higher level of environmental performance. By reusing or recycling we are: Contributing to the conservation of natural resources, Saving energy, Helping to protect the environment, Reducing landfill. We will also reduce our impact on the environment by minimizing the carbon emissions associated with both disposing of old products and obtaining new ones. Nilambazar College adopts environment friendly practices and takes necessary actions such as – energy conservation, waste recycling, carbon neutral etc. The biological reusable waste generated are processed as organic manure for the plants available in the college campus and the other solid waste generated in the college campus is taken to the nearby village for recycling and disposal.

Environmental studies (EVS): This is compulsory subject introduced by Assam University, Silchar for second semester students (all stream). Under this course students learn how to be an environmental friendly. They are made aware of:

- Renewable and Non-renewable energy sources
- 2) Energy conservation.
- E-waste management.
- 4) Green Campus Management.

4.6.1 Air Monitoring:

Air quality in the academic institute is very important for health of the students, faculty and staff of the institute. The air pollution sources in the college campus are wind storm, pollen grains, natural dust, vehicular emissions, generators, fires and laboratory fumes etc.

4.6.2. Noise Environment:

To aware the students of the college about noise pollution the college authority various bill-boards/ display boards in the Library and other areas of the college. The college authority announcet the library campus as a silence zone and accordingly place a display board. Other initiatives to make the college campus noise free campaigns and awareness about noise pollution are organized frequently.

Recommendations:

 Students and Staff are encouraged to reduce noise pollution with the boundaries college through uses of bicycles instead of Motor – cycles.



The main purpose of this is to reduce disposable waste in the college campus and manure thus produced is used in the floricultural activities within the campus. The main benefit of the process is to reduce the waste in the environment and also to generate awareness among students

Biodiversity available in the Campus:

Although Nilambazar College is located near by NH-08 covering 7 Bhigas land approx. The college capmus has big fishary in the southwestern side. The various spiecies of fishes are cultivated. The side bams of the fishary are also full of various kinds of vegitables and banana, battlenut trees etc. which lavishly increases the eco friendly atomosphere. Other plants available in the college campus includes fruit bearing trees, timber yielding trees, medicinal plants, ornamental plants etc. Among the species of birds, 08 bird species are sighted in the college campus belonging to 08 families which include some residential birds, common birds and winter migratory bird also.

5. Conclusions

Observation:-

The college premises has a rich collection of trees and plants. There is a beautiful garden in front of the college with proper fancing with some important display boards containing the important quotes and meaningful varses from prominent scholars which one is very attractive.

Recommendations:

To maintain the college campus green and eco-friendly, more trees need to be planted, Proper irrigation facilities need to be implemented. A gardener at daily basis should be appointed to maintain and take-care of the plants and garden of the college.

ENERGY AUDIT REPORT

NILAMBAZAR COLLEGE, NILAMBAZAR, KARIMGANJ, ASSAM

We are grateful to be a part of the preparation of Energy Audit Report of Nilambazar College, Nilambazar, Karimganj, Assam for the year 2021-22 (from 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2022). As a part of Audit methodology, we have visited Nilambazar College, Nilambazar, Karimganj, Assam on 24/04/2022 to collect data and to take some instantaneous measurements. We have studied the present energy consumption pattern, assessed the actual operating load, illumination study and energy conservation in lighting system. The summary of the Report is as follows -

- The average monthly energy consumption of the college campus is 303 units.
- Annual bill is Rs. 39,680.00/-
- 3. Average unit rate is Rs. 6.56/- (Grid Power)
- 4. Cost of Generator fuel for the year 2021-22 is Rs. 24,000/-
- No A/C is found in the campus.
- Tube lights used should be replaced by LED lights.
- Presently there is no personal transformer for college. It is recommended to install in extra transformer of at least 25 KVA for the college campus.
- 8. College has 30 kilowatt Diesel Generator set for uninterrupted power supply in case of supply failure from APDCL
- Open lid found in main panel box and need to be closed.
- Earthing should be taken through the panel instead of wall connection.
- Rusted wiring found in some place which needs to be replaced.
- 11. One set Solar LED Street lights is seen in the campus. Required solar energy to minimize electricity bill.
- The campus area is well facilitated with CCTVs for security purpose.
- 13. Load unbalancing found during field visit in electrical distribution system of campus area and hence load needs to be balanced.
- Distribution panel boxes need to be cleaned.

For the safety purpose, fire extinguisher are not sufficient in number in the campus area, hence; new fire extinguishers need based to be made available for every floor of the college buildings.

We, hope that this activity will improve the energy efficiency and reduce the overall energy consumption of the college campus.

a. Interview with Key Facility Personal

At the time of primary audit, a meeting is organized between the auditor and key operating personal to start the assignment. The agenda of the meeting focus on: audit objectives and scope of work, facility rules and regulations, roles and responsibility of project team members and description of schedule project activities.

b. Document Review

During the initial visit by the facility representatives, the available documentation are reviewed which includes all facility operation and maintenance procedures and logs – sheets/ registers for the previous years, electricity bills etc.

c. Facility Inspection

After a thorough review of the operating documentation of the institution, the major energy consuming processes in the facility are further investigated by the representatives.

d. Utility Analysis:

The utility analysis is a detailed review for the previous months. Data reviewed includes energy and energy consumption pattern.

e. Prepare a Report Summarizing Audit Findings:

The findings and recommendations are summarized in this report. The report includes a description of the facilities and their operation and a discussion of all major energy consuming systems.

The percentage of looking for the 1HP motor is 100% and for the 0.5 HP motor is 0% is acceptable as per the energy conservation measure.

8. Conclusion and recommendations:

Energy Management:

Following recommendations are made for eco-friendly energy consumption-

- Natural light should be used as far as possible to meet the required illumination level. Especially requirement of artificial light is less during daytime. While using the artificial lights care should be taken so as the lights in each area can be switched off partially when not in use. Also proper naming or numbering of the switches will facilitate the use of them by occupants or staff.
- 2. Maintenance & operating staff should be trained/informed about the energy management issues & procedures. To implement an effective preventive maintenance program, the operational staff must be given comprehensive training on each type of equipment, regarding system fundamentals, use of reference materials & manuals, maintenance procedures, service guidelines & warranty information. Proper maintenance schedules could be supplied to them for different equipment.
- 3. Replacement of remaining 20% tube lights by LED lights can help the institute to save a huge amount of electricity consumption.
- 4. Awareness can be created among the students for the efficient use of electricity and safety precaution and signboards may be hanged in the college campus for the efficient use of electricity.
- 5. Presently there is no personal transformer for college. It is recommended to install an extra transformer of at least 25 KVA for the college campus.














Report on
